We generally make plurals by adding *-s*. When the number of the same kind of person or thing is more than one, we add *-s* to it.

Look at some more examples of singular and plural:

table	tables
chair	chairs
room	rooms

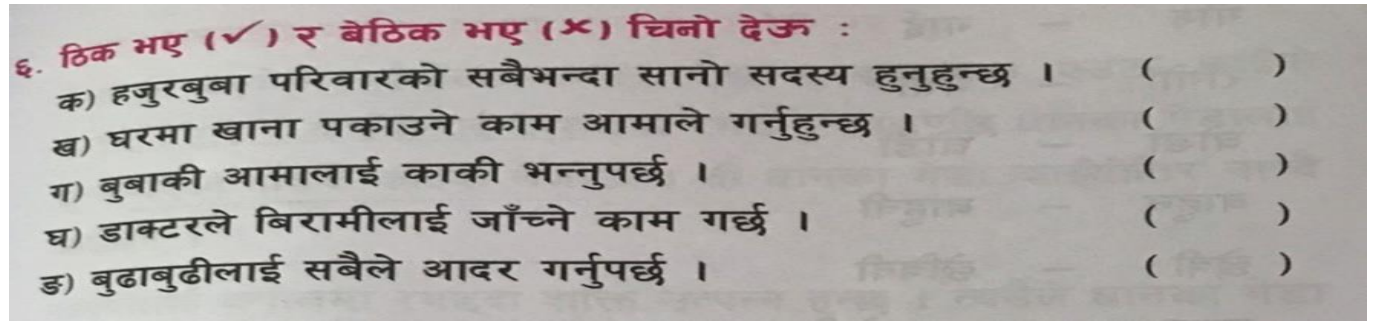
