Lesson –District Coordination Committee (DCC) and its Functions

a. Study the following text and answer the following questions:

Composition of the DCC

The DCC consists of 9 members who are elected by the District Assembly. The District Assembly consists of the Heads and Deputy-Heads of all the rural municipalities (chairpersons and vice-chairpersons) and the municipalities (mayors and deputy-mayors) in the district. The members are elected for a period of 5 years from/among the members of the Village Assembly or Municipal Assembly in the district. The Federal Government also appoints a LDO (Local Development Officer) in each DCC as its representative. The LDO works as the Secretary of the DCC and the District Assembly. Besides, s/he head the DCC in the absence of an elected Head (Coordinator) or Deputy-head (Deputy Coordinator). As per the provision, the DCC consists of the following members:

- i) Coordinator: 1
- ii) Women Members: At least 3
- iii) Other Members: 3
- iv) Deputy-coordinator: 1
- v) *Dalit*/ Minority Community Member: At least 1

Functions of the DCC

The functions of a DCC are stated as follows:

- i) To work as a link between local bodies (municipalities/rural municipalities within the district), and the Provincial and the Federal Governments (in the province and the centre);
- ii) To work as an executive body to the District Assembly

- iii) To settle down the disputes or misunderstanding (if any) of political nature among the local bodies
- iv) To help in implementing the concept of self-government/governance to local bodies
- v) To help in implementing the decisions made by the respective provinces/states; and to assure public participation in development and decision making
