Read this sentence:

Unknown to anyone, he hid her in a small room in his hut and secretly brought her food to eat.

un + known = unknown

Unknown is the antonym (opposite in meaning) of *known*.

The opposites of some words can be formed by adding before them *un*, *in*, *il*, *dis*, *ir* or *im*. These are called *prefixes*. The process of adding prefixes before words is called *prefixing*.
