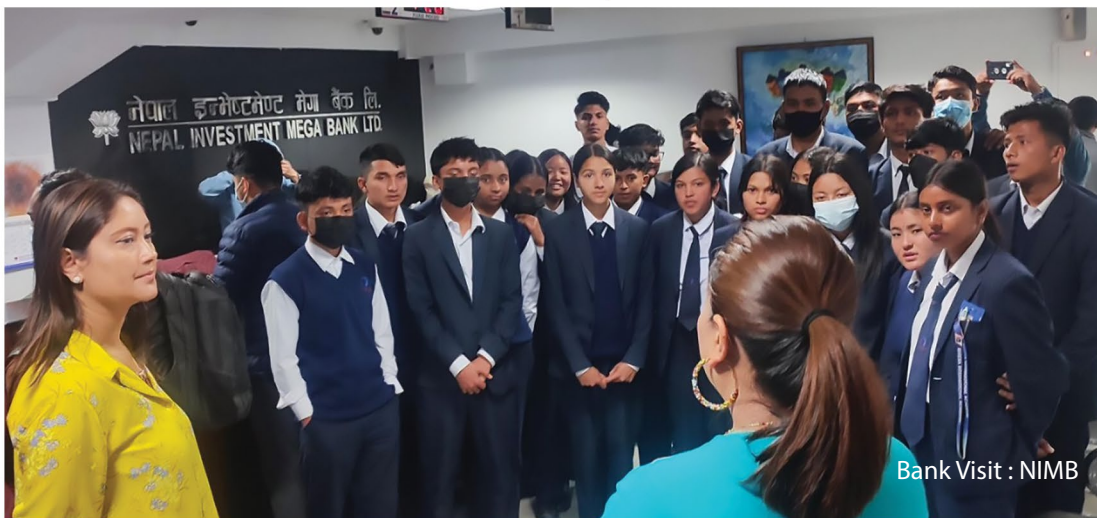

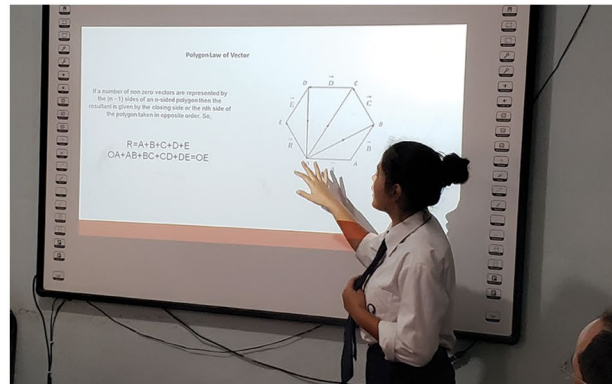
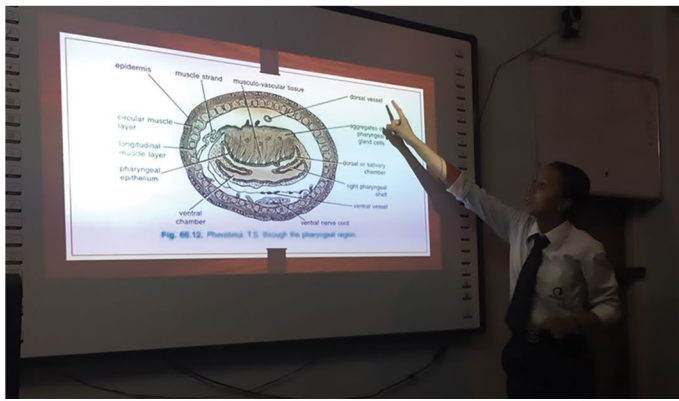

These reports clearly show that most of the time rape is carried out by family members, neighbors, friends etc. The Nirmala Panta rape and murder case (the last reported case of the murder of a schoolgirl that occurred on 23/10/2018 in Kathmandu, Nepal) is still unsolved.



INTRODUCTION

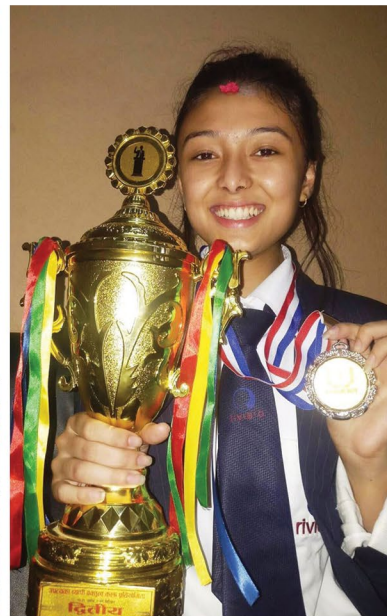
Human rights are moral principles or norms that describe certain standards of human behaviour and are regularly protected as national and legal right in municipal and international law. They are commonly understood as inalienable, fundamental rights to which a person is inherently entitled simply because she or he is a human being and which are inherent in all human beings, regardless of their nation, locations, language, religion, ethnic origin or any other status. They are applicable everywhere and at every time in the sense of being universal, and they are egalitarian in the sense of being the same for everyone.

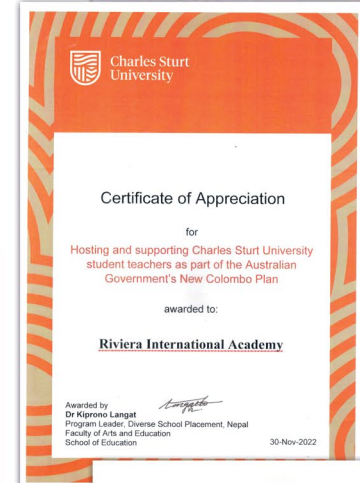

Admission Procedure

Applicants are required to fill in the application form and submit it to the administration along with the copies of grade-sheet of SEE, certificate, character certificate and two recent passport size photographs. They should qualify through a written test and an interview. Interview with parents/guardians is also mandatory. Admission is granted subject to the availability of seats and acceptance of all the rules delineated by the institution.
